## New Respite Benefit

Effective: January 1, 2014



For Families Who Have Children with Disabilities Enrolled in



Ohio Medicaid Managed Care Plans

If your Medicaid ID Card shows one of the following FIVE plan names:

Buckeye • Paramount • Molina • United Healthcare • CareSource

You may be eligible for in-home respite services!

## Some Key Points:

- > Children must be under the age of 21
- > Respite services can only be provided in the child's home
- > Respite services cannot be provided overnight
- > Receive up to 24 hours of respite per month or up to 250 hours per year
- > Providers must be employed by Medicaid/Medicare agencies
- > Plans do not contract with independent providers
- Each plan may contract with different agencies
- > Care coordinators will help families access respite services (if you don't have a care coordinator, please request one)
