It is important to collect the carts in a timely manner because loose carts in the parking lot can blow into cars or block driving lanes. Andrew enjoys using the electric cart pusher because it allows him to double his cart load, pushing up to 20 carts at a time instead of the 10-12 he can do by hand.

Not only has Andrew learned many new skills through his work, including the value of being kind to customers, but he has met many new friends as well. While the rain and freezing temperatures can sometimes make his work more difficult, Andrew still feels lucky to have a job and make his own money.

When Andrew is not at work, he likes to watch game shows and the Cleveland sports teams on TV. He also enjoys spending time doing activities at Metzenbaum Center's recreation department.
